Making his second start, the Kevin Gray-trained colt raced away with the 800m event to score with ease under jockey Kane Smith.

Out of the triple winning **Sound Reason** mare **Oenology**, he was bred by Judge Clapham who retained the colt to race after withdrawing him from the 2009 New Zealand Bloodstock Premier Yearling Sale.

A half-brother to the Gr.1 VRC Derby-placed **Our Bahare**, Cellarmaster's dam is a half-sister to the dual Gr.1 winner **Second Coming**. They are from the family of Gr.1 winners **In The Wings** and Champion older mare **Zomaradah**, who in turn is the dam of Dubawi.

Dubawi, the multiple Gr.1 winner, who was unbeaten as a two-year-old, was once again the stallion of choice last season, with Oenology due to foal any time now.

In Europe, he has had a highly successful first season and has notched up 31 individual winners, highlighted by the Gr.2 winners **Poet's Voice** and **Sand Vixen**.
