VOILA ICI STRIKES IN GR.1 PREMIO ROMA

Voila Ici added a Gr.1 victory to his record with a half a length success over the Gr.2 Derby Italiano runner-up **Turati (Lomitas)** in yesterday's Gr.1 Premio Roma, run in heavy going at Capannelle. The four-year-old Vittorio Caruso-trained colt became the second top flight winner for his sire, the South African-based **Daylami (Doyoun)**, whose first crop son, **Grey Swallow**, triumphed in the 2004 Irish Derby and the following season's Gr.1 Tattersalls Gold Cup. Daylami's seven Gr.1 victories included the Poule d'Essai des Poulains and Breeders' Cup Turf. Voila Ici runs in the colours of Scuderia Incolinx, who purchased him for \in 60,000 at the SGA Select Yearling Sale. He has three previous Group victories to his name, including this season's Gr.2 Prix Maurice de Nieuil.

Italian-trained runners filled the first three places, with **City Leader** (**Fasliyev**), the best of the British-trained trio in fourth.

The Gr.2 Premio Ribot on the same card was won by the outsider **Silver Arrow** (Silver Wizard), who defeated the proven German Group performer **Sehrezad** (Titus Livius) and had the globe-trotting dual Gr.1 winner **Pressing** (Soviet Star) back in third. It was the first Group success for the four-year-old, who is trained by Riccardo Menichetti.

The Listed Criterium Femminile went to **Orpen**'s juvenile daughter **Paloma Varga**, who has won twice previously this season.

GERMAN GR.3 FOR SON OF MEDICEAN

Cheveley Park Stud's **Medicean (Machiavellian)** was the sire of the day's big winner in Germany with his son **Neatico** leading home a one-two for trainer Peter Schiergen in the Gr.3 Herzog von Ratibor-Rennen at Krefeld. It was the second win from three outings for Gestut Ittlingen's homebred colt, who won by a length and three-quarters from his stablemate, the Gestut Fahrhof homebred **Cabimas (King's Best)**. Cheveley Park Stud also had a connection with the third, **Keep Cool (Starcraft**), who was bred by them and sold as a foal.

Thanks partly to an ever-increasing number of Breeders' Cup races, Europe's haul of six victories over the two-day, 14-race spectacular was one better than the 2008 total.

Europeantrained runners won half of Saturday's eight races, though they missed out on the big one when Twice Over had to settle for third behind the mighty Zenyatta and Gio Ponti.
